#### **Event Headquarters**

Great Amwell Parish Hall, Hillside Lane, Great Amwell, Ware, Hertfordshire SG12 9SH. Sign on will open at 5pm. Bags and kit can be left at the event HQ at owners risk.


The event HQ is located between Ware and Hoddesdon near St Margarets railway station, From St Margarets station go north on Amwell Lane, turning left onto Cautherly Lane and left again onto Hillside Lane. If you are coming with a car from the A10 turn off on to the A414. At the first roundabout, take the 2nd exit onto Pepper Hill (A1170) and after ~200m turn right onto Cautherly Lane. The next right is Hillside Lane where the event HQ is located. Overflow parking will be provided in a nearby field. Please park with consideration for local residents.

#### Course Information: F20/10

- The start is on the A10 south of Rush Green roundabout.
- Arrive at the event HQ with plenty of time to sign on and to ride to the start.
- To cycle to the start from the event HQ follow Hillside Lane north and turn right onto Cautherly Lane. Cross Pepper Hill (A1170) with care, and proceed on

Gypsy Lane, before turning right onto Stanstead Road (B1502). Turn onto the A10 at Rush Green roundabout with care and proceed to the start lay-by.


- The route is marshalled and signed but it is your responsibility to know the course.
- You should arrive at the start on time but not more than 5 minutes early. The start assistant will call your number when you are the next rider to start.



#### **Course Description: F20/10**

- Start (GR 358126) on A10 southbound carriageway at southern end of lay-by approximately half a mile south of Rush Green elevated roundabout (junction of A10 and A414) at 6<sup>th</sup> cats eye north of post marked 51/28. Proceed south past exits for A414 Harlow and A1170 Hoddesdon, to:
- Turn (4.8 miles) at Turnford elevated roundabout. (signposted Broxbourne, Wormley, Turnford A1170). Take second exit onto slip road to join A10 northbound. Continue north on A10 past exits for A1170 Hoddesdon and A414 Harlow, to:-
- Finish at first cat's-eye south of northern end of island in lay-by, roughly half a mile south of Rush Green elevated roundabout.
- N.B. On finishing riders must not stop, but continue riding to take first exit (A414) to Rush Green elevated roundabout and make their way back to the event HO.

### **Local Regulations:**

- No U turns should be made in sight of the start or finish areas.
- No cars other than that of the timekeeper(s) and other event officials are to be parked in the vicinity of the start or finish points.
- In order to avoid milling about and congestion at the start riders should not go to the start more than 5 minutes before their due time. The timekeeper or other club official should ensure that riders do not congest or obstruct the layby for other users.

#### For your information and safety

- Safety not performance is your first priority.
- The wearing of a helmet is recommended.
- For visibility race numbers are printed on a bright, reflective background. The number must be placed on your shorts from the waistband downwards, and must not be covered by other clothing.
- We recommend that riders use lights, even during daytime.
- Any road junction or roundabout can constitute a hazard in a race be aware.
- At roundabouts the traffic coming from the right has priority over you, so please give way.
- If you have an accident during a race, no matter how minor, you are required to report it to the Event Secretary as soon as possible.
- Observe the law and highway code at all times
- Avoid u-turns and dangerous manoeuvres while warming up, approaching the start and leaving the finish.
- Keep your head up at all times look where you are going.

**Juniors:** The minimum age for competitors is 12 years. In accordance with Regulation 15 all junior competitors must wear protective hard shell helmets. Riders under 18 years must know the law and the Highway Code, and be competent to ride on public roads alone. A CTT permission form must be returned to the event HQ.
